The school is directed to ensure that:

The total number of section of the school after upgradation, shall be restricted to 16 (As per prescribed dimension) out of which, not more than 1/3rd sections may be used to run Senior Secondary classes and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.

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The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 16 as per the number of sections reported during inspection, and numbers of students are restricted 32 (as per dimension), of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes and further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation by e law subject to availability of class rooms of greater than 500 ft dimension. The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets, but they are very small and narrow and there is no room for negotiating the movement of a wheelchair/walker. The school shall make provision for spacious separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board and submit compliance within 3 months on SARAS. The school is required to shift the library in bigger room and make 4 separate reading space for staff within 03 months and submit the compliance. The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Dehradun within 3 months and submit the compliance. Failure to submit compliance on the above mentioned points within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty against the school. The school shall not remove the videography links in the mandatory 7 disclosure section of its website and renew all mandatory certificates from time to time

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- a. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
